### **Camp Policy**

Welcome to the City of Birmingham Rockets Hakeem Olajuwon Basketball Residential Summer Camp 2026! This camp offers a unique opportunity for intensive training and development in a residential setting. Please review the following camp policies for a smooth and enjoyable experience:

#### **1. Registration and Fees**

- **Registration:** All participants must complete and submit the registration form to secure a place in the camp.
- **Payment:** Deposit or Full payment of the camp fees is required at the time of registration. Payment plans are not available for this camp.

#### **2. Camp Dates and Times**

- **Camp Schedule:** Week one of the camp will run from Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August to Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2026, week two will run from Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> August – Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2026 with participants staying on-site for the duration of the camp.
- **Check-In/Check-Out:** Participants must check in on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August between 1pm and 4pm. Check-out will be on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August by 12.30pm. Late arrivals or early departures should be communicated in advance to camp staff.

#### **3. Accommodation and Supervision**

- **Accommodation:** Participants will be housed in designated residential facilities provided by the camp.
- **Supervision:** Chaperones and coaches will supervise participants throughout their stay, ensuring their safety and well-being.

#### **4. Code of Conduct**

- **Behaviour:** Participants are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and sportsmanlike manner at all times, both on and off the court.

- **Discipline:** Any disruptive behaviour, bullying, or disrespect towards coaches, chaperones, staff, or fellow campers will not be tolerated and may result in dismissal from the camp without refund.

## 5. Health and Safety

- **Medical Information:** Parents/guardians must provide accurate medical information and emergency contact details during registration.
- **Illness/Injury:** Participants who are ill or injured should not attend camp. Please notify camp staff if a participant becomes ill or injured during camp.
- **Hygiene:** Participants are expected to maintain good personal hygiene, including regular showering and proper attire.

## 6. Equipment and Attire

- **Appropriate Attire:** Participants should wear comfortable athletic clothing and appropriate footwear suitable for basketball activities.
- **Personal Items:** Campers are responsible for their own belongings. The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
